A social worker experienced in various psychosocial and clinical interventions helps family members cope with the practical and emotional realities they face while caring for a child with a life-limiting illness.

Group Counselling

Parent support groups bring together parents and caregivers who are going through or have gone through similar experiences during a child's illness progression. Group counselling provides a safe space to share thoughts, emotions and coping strategies and build a community with other caregivers.

Families with children being cared for by the CHEO palliative care team can access individual and group counselling during illness progression.
