## Before Discharge from the Hospital

Our team will provide you and the inhospital team caring for your child admitted to the hospital with an additional layer of support.

While the in-hospital team will provide necessary education/training and connect with the Home and Community Care team to coordinate resources and supplies, our team will be available to support.

# At Discharge from the Hospital

In some cases, additional support may be of benefit. In those cases, an admission to Roger Neilson Children's Hospice after discharge from the hospital and before returning home can be coordinated.

In these instances, you will accompany your child during their Transition from Hospital to Home admission at Roger Neilson Children's Hospice to provide care and work towards learning goals with the 24/7 support of our team.
